"It makes a big difference."

Willie has been raising two of her grandchildren, ages 3 and 13, since they were born. She loves them as though they were her own, but taking care of them is a full-time job at her age.

Willie has been disabled since 1992. She receives disability assistance for both herself and her grandson, but this isn't nearly enough to pay for rent, utility bills, medications and food. Since both children are at crucial stages in development, it's important for them to have regular access to nutritious food. Willie says her 13-year-old grandson is hungry almost all the time.

"He eats all night long!" she laughs. "And the 3-year-old is getting that way, too."

Her oldest grandson participates in the free lunch program at his school, which helps supplement Willie's budget. But she still needs to keep enough food at home for everyone – and more often than not, she simply can't afford to do so.

That's why she's so grateful that she can come to the food pantry at the Southside Church of Christ in Fort Worth for

nutritious groceries whenever she needs them. This partner agency of Tarrant Area Food Bank provides important grocery staples to individuals and families in need. One food pantry volunteer says that they recently served 148 families in the span of just two hours.

Willie is so thankful for the food she receives for herself and her grandchildren. Thanks to you, she doesn't have to worry about how she will feed her family.

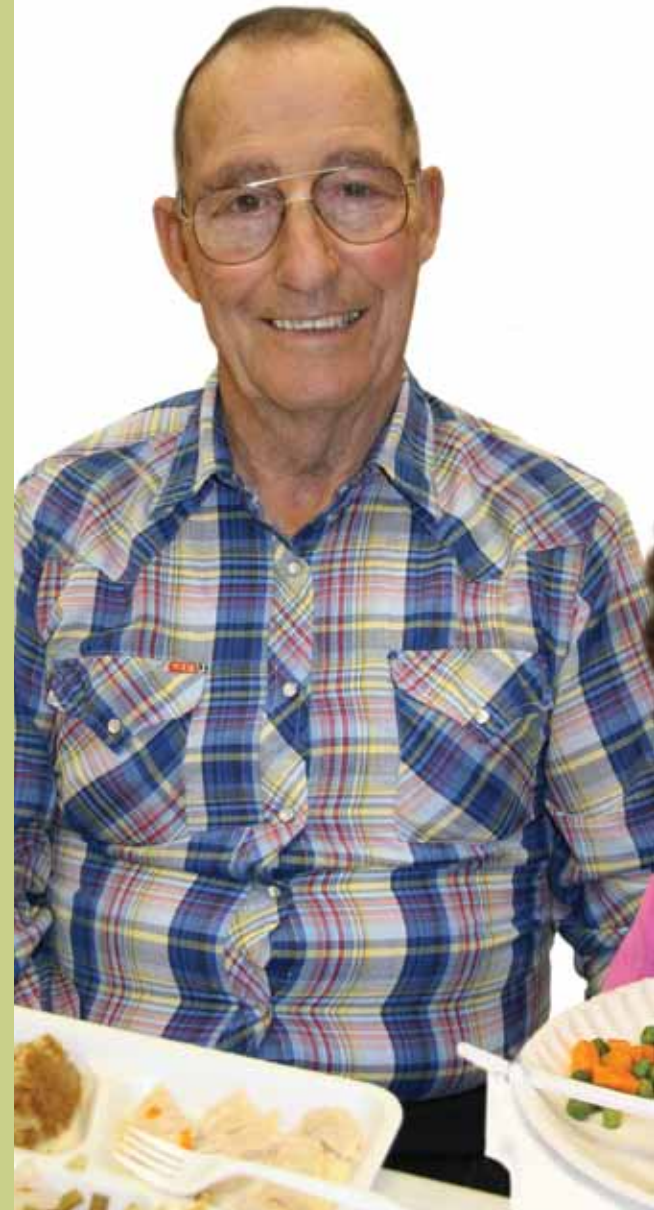

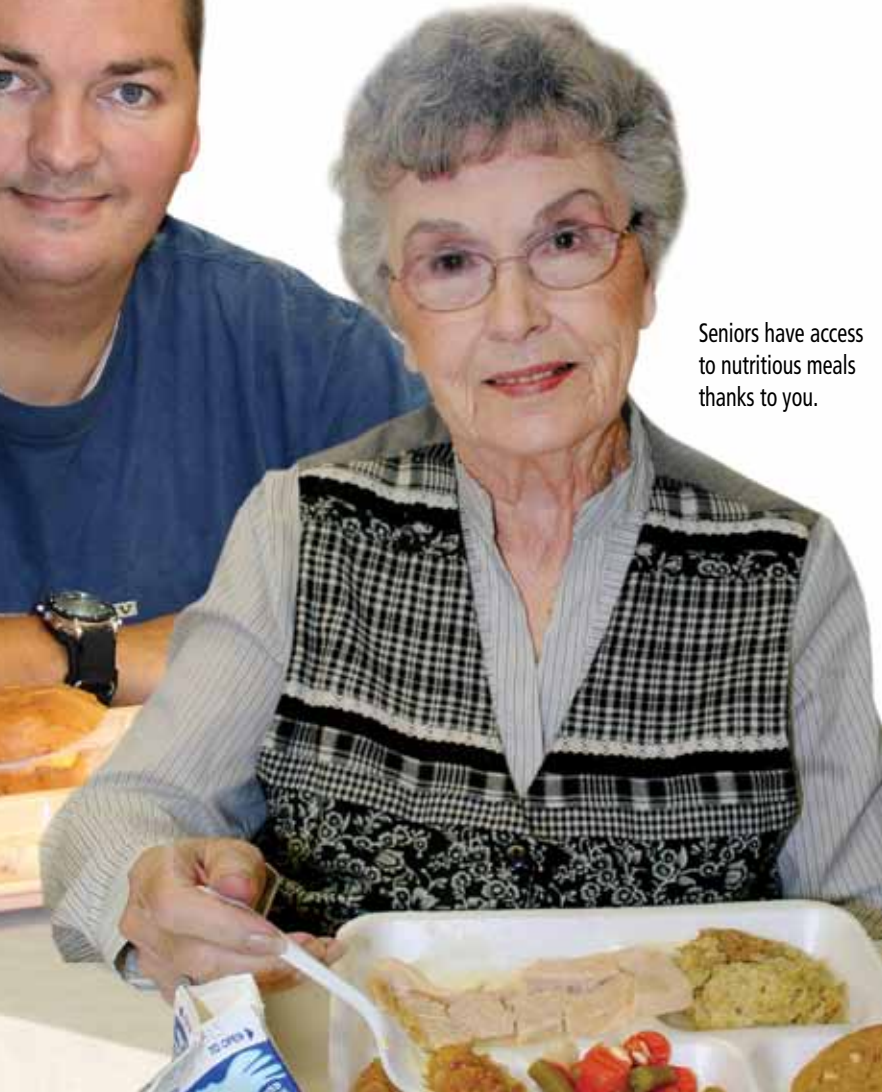

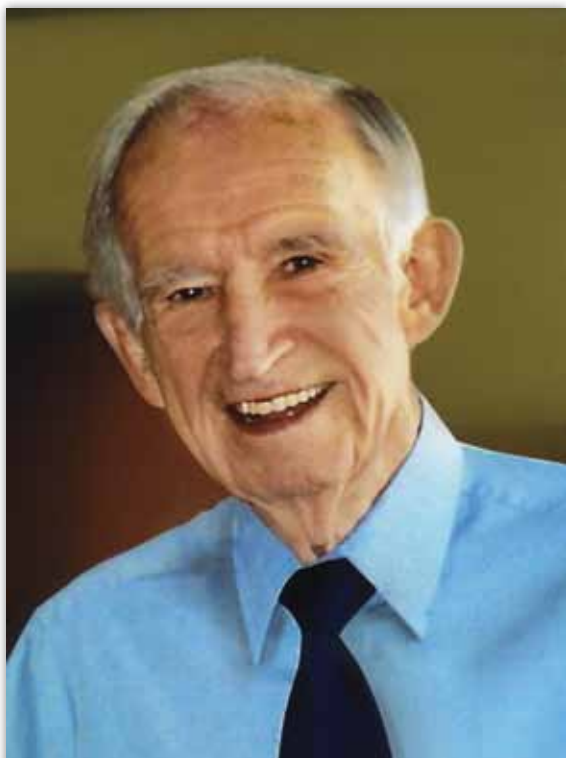

A LASTING LEGACY



Ozzie Osterborg | 1923-2009

Tarrant Area Food Bank is grateful to have the tireless energy and commitment of many dedicated volunteers. Though Ozzie Oesterborg only served at the Food Bank for two years, his commitment to our mission to feed those in need will be remembered for decades to come.

Ozzie and his wife, Rosie, began volunteering at the Food Bank in 2007 through their church in Fort Worth. It wasn't long before Ozzie realized that helping to feed hungry families and individuals wouldn't be just a one-time thing for him – it would become a way of life.

“It quickly became a passion,” Rosie remembers. “He fell in love with it and was so dedicated to it.”

Ozzie and Rosie began volunteering at the Food Bank three times a week. Rosie says Ozzie made a point to reach out to the other volunteers and always made everyone feel included. Despite several health problems, he rarely missed a day. Serving at the Food Bank was his priority.

“He'd go with his [portable] oxygen [tank]; he'd go however he could go,” says Rosie. “He loved the people. He didn't miss an opportunity to encourage somebody.”

Rosie is confident that Ozzie would have volunteered at the Food Bank for the next 10 years. But on October 25, 2009, the couple was involved in a serious car accident. Though Rosie was uninjured, Ozzie passed away shortly afterward. He was 86 years old.

Rosie says she knows her husband led a full life – and she's glad his last two years were spent in such a fulfilling way, giving back to those in need. She encourages others to do the same, no matter how old they are or where they are in life.

“Many seniors don't realize they can be involved,” she says. “Everybody can do something. Every bit makes a difference!”

We are so grateful for Ozzie's tireless dedication throughout the last two years of his life, and for Rosie's steadfast commitment alongside him. It's the support of these hardworking volunteers and community leaders that make our work possible. Thank you.
